## 1. Product profile

### 1.1 General description

Logic level N-channel enhancement mode Field-Effect Transistor (FET) in a plastic package using TrenchMOS technology. This product has been designed and qualified to the appropriate AEC standard for use in automotive critical applications.

- Low conduction losses due to low on-state resistance
- Suitable for logic level gate drive sources
- Suitable for thermally demanding environments due to 175 °C rating

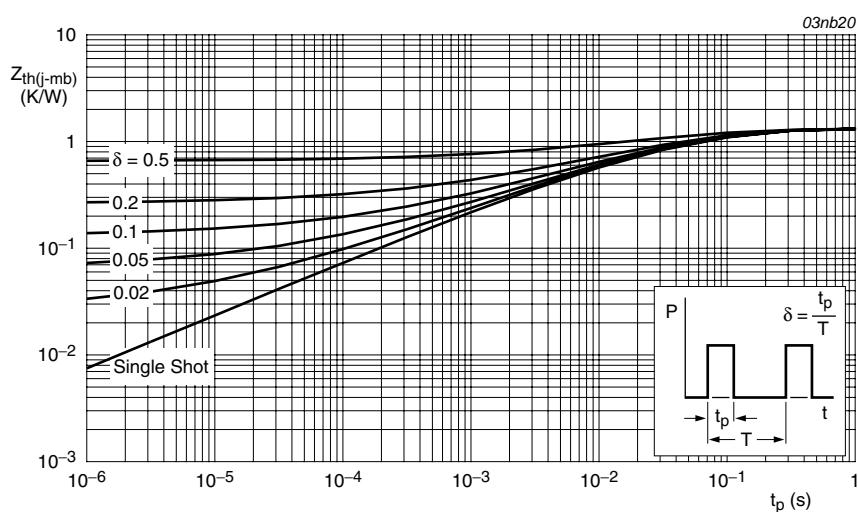

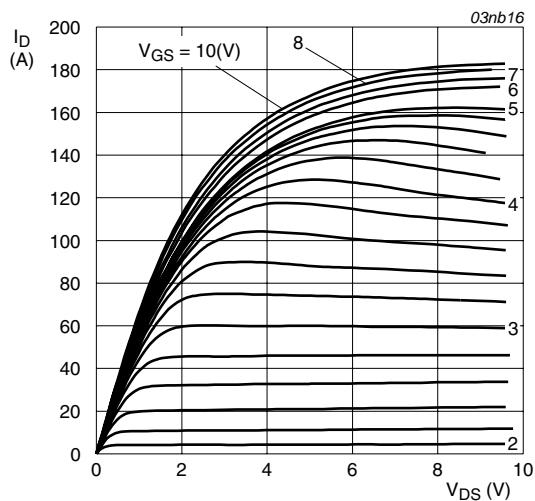


**Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration**

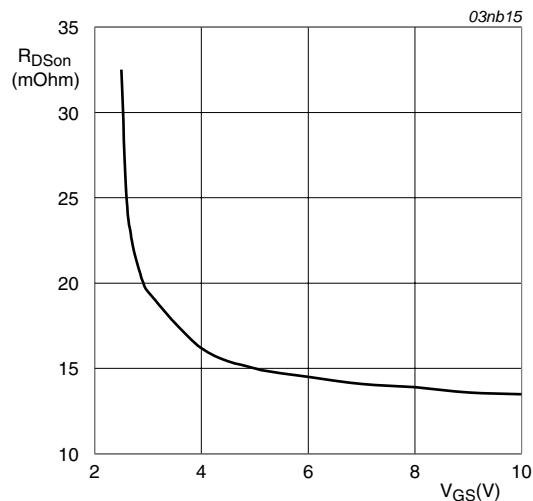

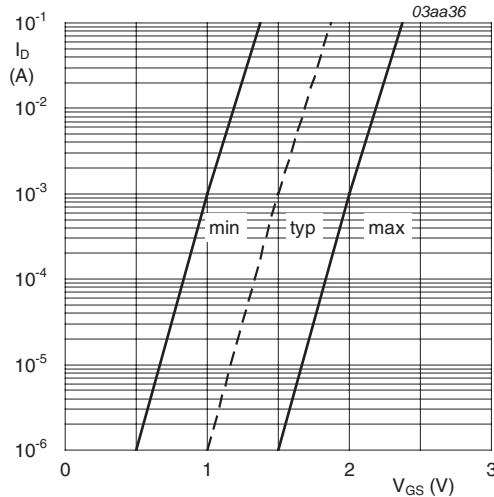

**Fig 5.** Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values



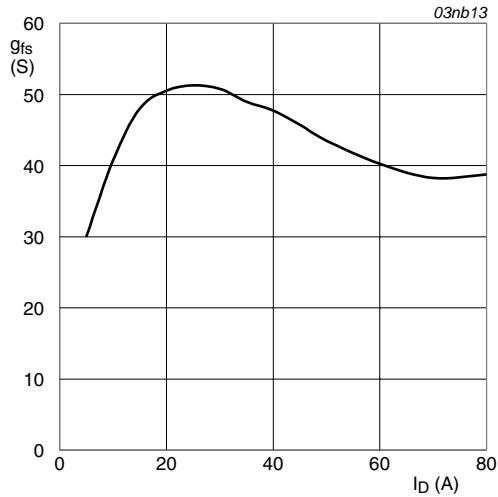

**Fig 6.** Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values



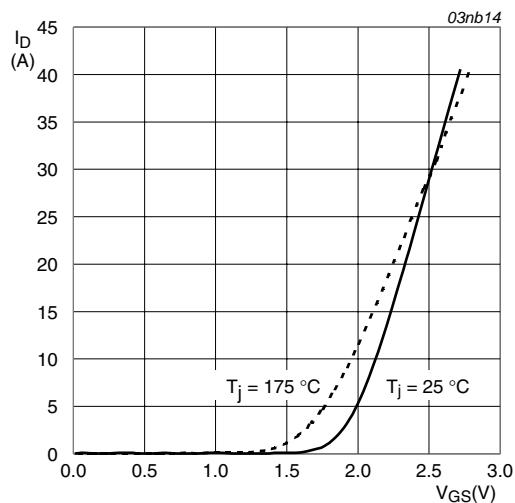

**Fig 7.** Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage

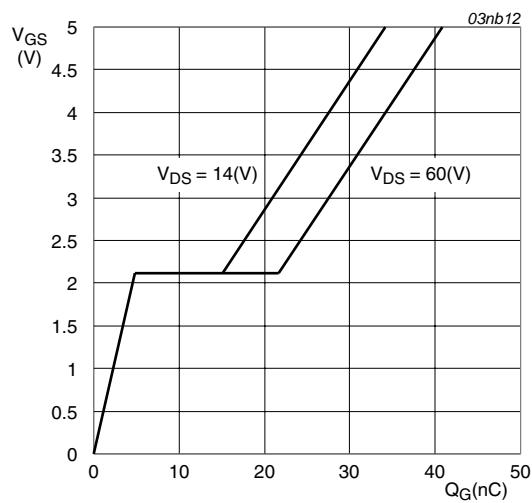

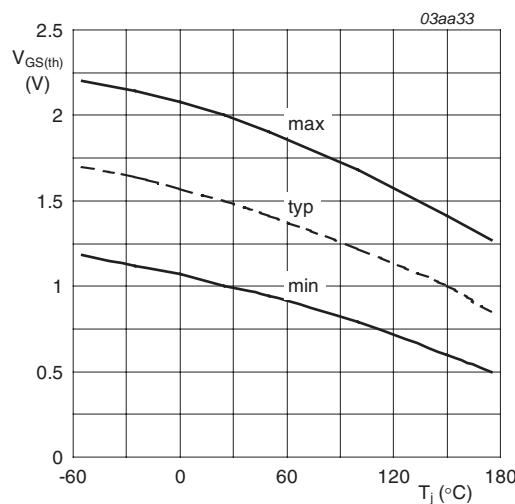
**Fig 8.** Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values

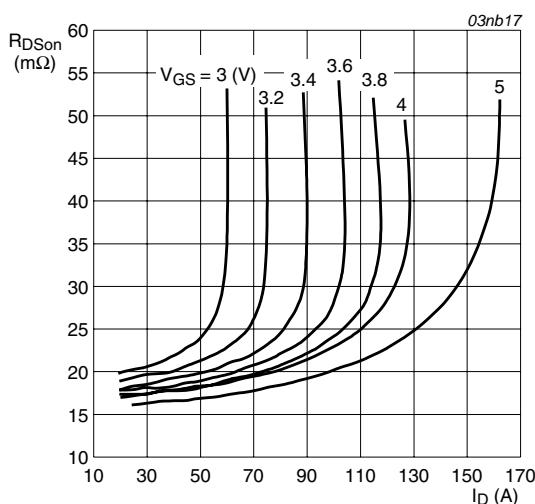
**Fig 9. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values**


 $T_j = 25^\circ\text{C}; I_D = 25\text{A}$ 

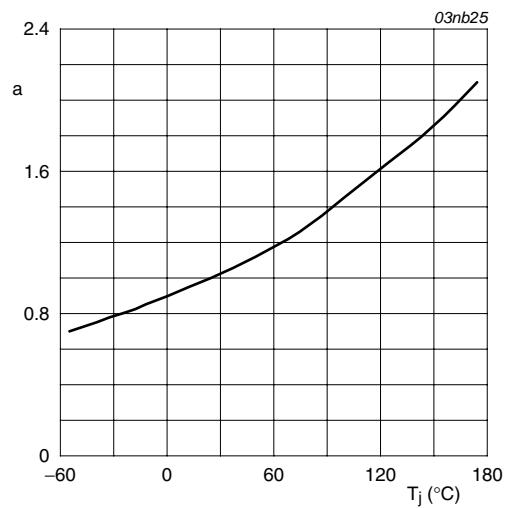
**Fig 10. Gate-source voltage as a function of turn-on gate charge; typical values**

**Fig 11. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature**

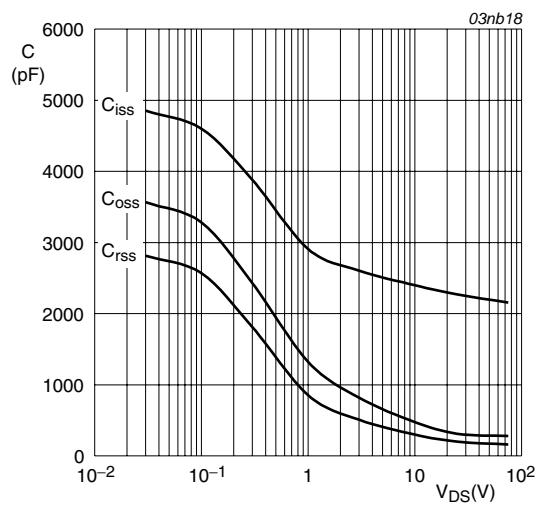

**Fig 12. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values**



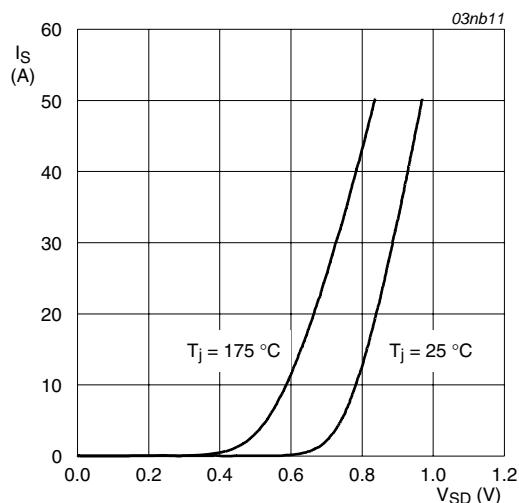

**Fig 14. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values**



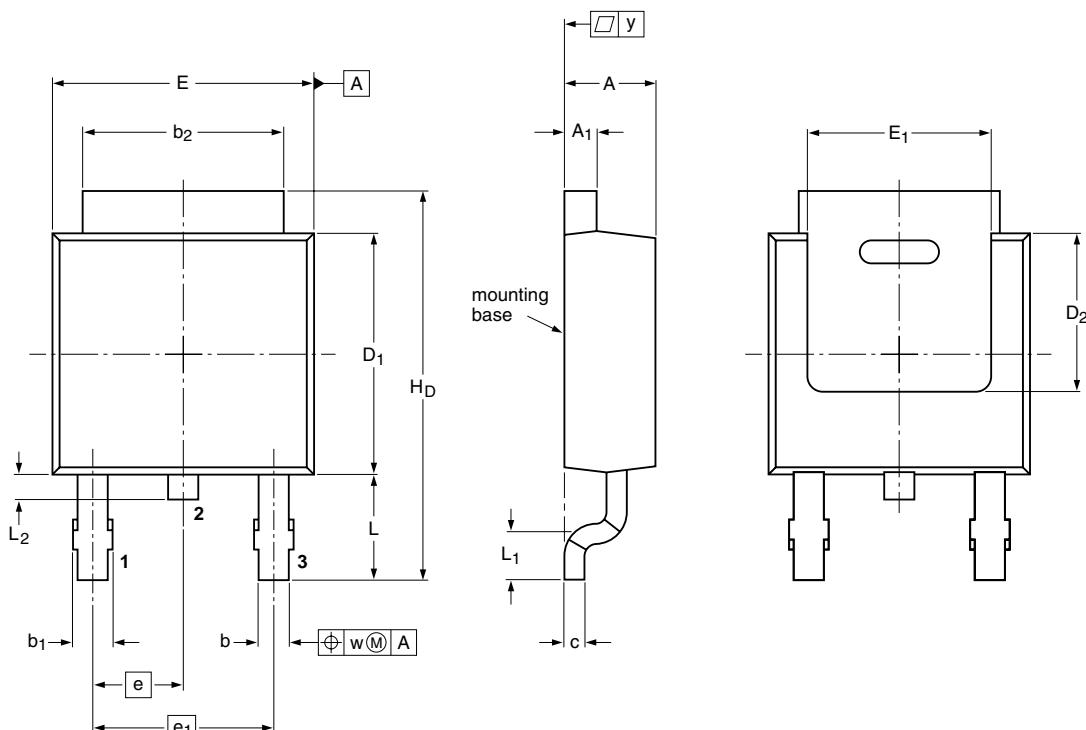
