## SUBJECT: Information on Restriction of Hazardous Substance (RoHS) Directive

Cal Test Electronics, Inc., is committed to reducing or eliminating hazardous material from its test and measurement products and to promote recycling or reuse.

Cal Test's products are classified under ANNEX I, Category 9: Monitoring and control instruments including industrial monitoring and control instruments, and Article 3 (24), of Directive 2011/65/EU (recast). This directive or RoHS 2, established by the European Union, restricts the use of six substances in electrical and electronics products.

(Maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials)

Directive 2011/65/EU, specified six restricted substances. Original six (6) substances:

- Lead (pb) : 0.1% \*
- Mercury (Hg) : 0.1%
- Cadmium (Cd) : 0.01%
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr VI) : 0.1%
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) : 0.1%
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) : 0.1%

Directive 2015/863, is an amendment to the RoHS 2 and adds 4 substances. Four (4) substances:

- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) : 0.1%
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP) : 0.1%
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) : 0.1%
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) : 0.1%

To this end, Cal Test has worked diligently with its global supply partners to transition all of its products to RoHS 2 compliance. All new products are designed to also comply with the directive. Cal Test products are compliant to Directive 2015/863 substances in that they are Category 9 and exempt until 22-JUL-2021.

\* Exemption 6(c) per Directive 2011/65/EU, Annex III, "Copper alloy containing up to 4% lead by weight," is still effective with a new expiration date for 21-JUL-2024, per (EU) 2018/741.
